Past Simple: There+ To be

	Afirmative	Negative	Interrogative
Singular:	There was	There wasn't	Was there?
Plural:	There were	There weren't	Were there?

EXAMPLES:

THERE TO BE

Present

Singular: There is a boy outside.

Plural: There are some seats left.

Past

Singular: There was a student talking.

Plural: There were 10 students talking.
